#### HOW TO MAKE YOUR FUTURE OCCUPATIONAL CHOICES

# Have you ever made a choice and you were changing it all the time afterwards?

If you want to be sure about your occupational choices, there are some steps that you can follow so your career will be ideal for your expectations!

#### STEP 1: SELF ASSESMENT

At this first step you have to gather information about yourself by using a variety of tools, like Minnesota Importance Questionnaire (MIQ), Survey of Interpersonal Values (SIV), or Temperament and Values Inventory (TVI). The results of these tests are depented on your interests, work - related values, aptitutes, preferred wors environments, developmental needs and realities. It would be good to choose to hire a career counselor who will administer a variety of self assessment inventories.

### STEP 2: CAREER EXPLORATION

For a career exploration you should read about the occupations that appear to be a good fit based on the results of your self assessment and learn about any other occupations that interest you. Also, at this step it would be good to use labor market information to gather more data about these occupations and about the industries in which you might work.

This is a good time to conduct informational interviews and arrange job shadowing opportunities. On an informational interview, you will ask people employed in an occupation that interests you questions about his or her job. Job shadowing involves following someone around at work in order to learn more about a career.

#### STEP 3: MATCH

When you will accomplish step 1 and step 2, you will be ready to fit an occupation that is the best for you. You should give serious thought to how you will prepare to enter your chosen career, the costs associated with education and training, and whether you will face any barriers.

#### INTODUCTION

It is commonly known that each person has defferent values, aptitudes, interests and values. A future occupational choice has to be taken when these characteristics are combined with the personality type. For many people the proccess of making an occupational choice is a stressful and frightening prospect.

Make good choices today so you don't have regrets tomorrow.

#### STEP 4: ACTION

Finally you did it! Now it's time to put together a plan to reach your goals and start moving forward. First, you should write a career action plan where you should identify your long-term and short-term goals. Then, it would be ideal to apply to colleges or graduate schools or an apprenticeship program and develop a job search stratégy. At the very final stage, you should compose cover letters and prepare for job interviews.

This month we have done a quick insight and welcomed Milen Yanev, a 27 year old Bulgarian DJ owning his successful company MAX Event, selling over one million records in 2016 in the whole Europe. Although Milen began his professional career in his eighteens, he was already djing at home since his fourteens. He has study the Technical University in Varna with a master degree of Management and Industrial Engineering. "But music has always been my dream, in particular deep house. It was my first choice and the devotion of the most of my time." Milen comments the djing as not only being a more profitable profession, but also much more enjoyable.

He has become an entrepreneur and settled up his own Djing company in 2015, ranking MAX Event a number one in Google. In the beginning things were not easy at all, Milen was still studying and he had to borrow a lot of money to get himself a proper equipment (2 Pioneers CDJ 2000 Nexus), but he never gives up, for him there are just things he wants to do and doesn't want to. So little by little his name started to become more and more famous and people were recognizing him on the streets. Nowadays he is playing on private parties, events and in fancy bars, choosing only high clients, his team consisting of four members.

Milen's day is completely different from the ordinary days of the majority of the people. As he is a workoholic and obsessed with his dream job, he goes to sleep at 5 a.m. and wakes up at 10 a.m. because from that time the clients are starting to call him and he starts to check the facebook with new music. That basically means only five hours of sleep per a day. But this life is a life he has chosen and every day he has to listen to thousands of songs to find THE right one and make it a hit of the party. Milen is simply the brave man, who knows what the DJing industry needs. His advice to the world is: "If you don't make a first step, you will never be a successful entrepreneur. Make a profit from your profit"
